

Enforcement of the Coaches Code Of Conduct

The parishes, under the supervision of the CYO Seattle Archdiocesan Office, shall enforce this code. Complaints regarding violations of this code must first be brought to the attention of the Parish Athletic Director (PAD) of the parishes/schools involved. Coaches, participants or spectators may be placed on probation or suspended from CYO activities for their actions. All parents must sign this Coaches Code of Conduct – both Head and Assistant Coaches. If there is no signed Coaches Code of Conduct by a coach, the team is ineligible in all CYO Seattle Athletic events.

- I acknowledge that I have read the Coaches Code of Conduct and my signature indicates that I am willing to abide to these guidelines for the 2007-2008 CYO Seattle Athletic Season. If I do not agree to the CYO Seattle Archdiocesan Coaches Code of Conduct – then I will not be allowed to coach any team involved with Seattle CYO Athletics. I am aware that a signed Coaches Code of Conduct with my signature will be kept on file with the Parish Athletic Director (PAD) for the current CYO Seattle Athletic year.
